FINAL ORDER

This matter came before the Commission on Ethics (Commission), meeting in public session on January 21, 2022, on the timely appeal of Appellant, pursuant to Section 112.3145(8)(g), Florida Statutes, which assesses an automatic fine of \$25 per day on a person who fails to timely file a required CE Form 1, Statement of Financial Interests. The Commission may waive the fine in whole or in part for good cause shown, based on "unusual circumstances" surrounding the failure to file by the designated date. There are no matters in dispute. Appellant has not requested a hearing before the Commission.

Findings of Fact

- 1. According to information provided to the Commission, the Appellant served as the City Attorney for North Miami Beach, a position that requires the filing of a CE Form 1, "Statement of Financial Interests," for the year 2019. In 2020, the designated due date for submitting a 2019 CE Form 1 annual filing was July 1, 2020, with a grace period ending on September 1, 2020.
- 2. On March 19, 2020, the Appellant resigned from her public position in Aventura and relocated to Tampa.

- 3. On May 29, 2020, the Miami-Dade County Supervisor of Elections mailed a 2019 CE Form 1 to the Appellant's address on file, 3001 NE 185th St., Apartment 538, Aventura, FL 33180-3346. The same Form 1 was also circulated in the Appellant's office via email.¹
- 4. On July 31, 2020, the Miami-Dade County Supervisor of Elections mailed a second 2019 CE Form 1 to the Appellant's new address, 3409 W Horatio St., Unit 112, Tampa, FL 33609-3980.
- 5. On August 27, 2020, the Commission notified the Appellant of her obligation to file a CE Form 1 for the year 2019. This notification was sent to the Appellant via her public email and was returned as 'undeliverable.' On the same day, the Commission sent the same notification to the Appellant's private email address.
- 6. On September 9, 2020, the Commission sent the Appellant a courtesy notice indicating that fines were beginning to accrue as her 2019 CE Form 1 had not been received. This notice was mailed to the Appellant's Tampa address.
- 7. On September 22, 2020, the Appellant contacted the Commission and stated orally that she had incorrectly submitted a 2019 Form 1F thrice during the preceding two months. However, the Appellant, upon realizing that she had filed the incorrect form, was immediately provided the correct 2019 Form 1 via email. On the same day, the Appellant submitted her 2019 CE Form 1 to the Commission. Also, the 2019 CE Form 1 was filed with the Miami-Dade County Supervisor of Elections.
- 8. On February 26, 2021, the Commission sent a Notice of Assessment of Automatic Fine to the Appellant for the twenty one (21) day delay in filing her 2019 Form 1, assessing the

Appellant with a \$525 fine. The Notice was sent to the Appellant's Tampa address. It indicated the total of Appellant's accrued automatic fine, and included a notice of the right to appeal the fine, stating that the appeal had to be received by the Commission by March 29, 2021.

9. On March 29, 2021, the Appellant timely filed an appeal with the Commission and in a subsequent correspondence, the Commission acknowledged Appellant's appeal as received. In the appeal, the Appellant claimed that while the 2019 Form 1 had been sent to and circulated within her former office, she no longer worked there and experienced extended delays in receiving mail from her old address. In her appeal, she further asserted experiencing difficulty in confirming receipt of her Form filings with the Miami-Dade Supervisor of Elections and that these delays were worsened by the statewide pandemic emergency in effect. Moreover, the Appellant attaches to her appeal an email exchange wherein she sent a financial disclosure form to the Miami-Dade Financial Disclosure Portal indicating that she had made a similar submission twice before the grace period. However, it was only on September 22, 2020, that the Appellant realized that 2019 Form 1, as opposed to Form 1F, was the correct form required from her. Finally, in her appeal, Appellant asserts that throughout the filing process, she did make several bona fide and good faith efforts to comply with her disclosure obligations.

Conclusions of Law

- 11. The Commission has jurisdiction over the subject matter of this proceeding pursuant to Section 112.3145, Florida Statutes.
- 12. Financial disclosure is required of public officials and employees because it enables the public to evaluate potential conflicts of interest, deters corruption, and increases public confidence in government.
 - 13. Section 112.3145(8)(g), Florida Statutes, states:

Any reporting person may appeal or dispute a fine, based upon unusual circumstances surrounding the failure to file on the designated due date, and may request and is entitled to a hearing before the commission, which may waive the fine in whole or in part for good cause shown. Any such request must be in writing and received by the commission within 30 days after the notice of payment due is transmitted. In such a case, the reporting person must, within the 30-day period, notify the person designated to review the timeliness of reports in writing of his or her intention to bring the matter before the commission. For purposes of this subparagraph, the term "unusual circumstances" does not include the failure to monitor an e-mail account or failure to receive notice if the person has not notified the commission of a change in his or her e-mail address.

14. Here, the notice to file the 2019 Form 1 was sent to the Appellant's previous address and her former work email address prior to the expiration of the grace period on September 1, 2020. While the Appellant does not claim that she never received them as she had changed positions and was working in a different city, she does claim that there was a lack of communication and delay in mail, fueled by a state wide pandemic emergency. Her claim is supported by facts on record and the need for a fine is further mitigated by the promptness of her corrective action. There is no evidence showing that the Appellant affirmatively received a timely notice of her filing obligation; instead, there is evidence that the Appellant did make a diligent effort to ensure compliance and would be in compliance but for the filing of the wrong form. Also, the Appellant's job change coincided with delayed mail deliveries and an inability to timely confirm delivery of her filings with the Miami-Dade Supervisor of Elections. Based on these facts, the Commission believes that "unusual circumstances" do exist that justify waiving the \$525 fine.

<u>Order</u>

Based on the foregoing facts and conclusions of law, the Commission hereby waives the assessed fine of \$525.

Please see the below as the explanation for Part C: Detailed Explanation of Your Appeal:

On March 19, 2020, I resigned from my public position and relocated from Aventura to Tampa, this coincided with statewide shutdown orders resulting in widespread impacts including delayed mail service.

On June 9, 2020, I filed the Form 1F, shortly thereafter, I was made aware by a paralegal at my law firm that the County website indicated I had not filed the required form. I re-submitted the form several times over the next two months, believing there was a clerical error. I made attempts to confirm compliance after submitting the form but was unable to receive any kind of confirmation or indication that it was the incorrect form. Although I kept following up and submitting the form, it was not until September 22, 2020, when I spoke with someone at the state that I was made aware that the form I was sending was the Form 1F and the form that was needed was the Form 1.

The first written notification I received was a notice from the State on August 28th, upon receipt of that notice (which was sent to my old address), I immediately re-submitted the form to the Miami-Dade County Supervisor of Elections. The next communication I received was on September 22, 2020, at which time I re-sent the form and called-it was only after finally speaking with someone that I was made aware that the Form 1 that was missing, not the Form 1F which I had submitted several times.

Throughout this process I made several attempts to confirm compliance and followed up each time. Between the extended delays in receiving mail, a lack of communication from the local supervisor of elections, a change in jobs and a move across the state during a pandemic there was unique circumstances which resulted in the extended delay in complying with filing the Form 1.

Any consideration to reducing/waiving the fines would be greatly appreciated.

Candidates must file at the same time they file their qualifying papers.

Thereafter, file by July 1 following each calendar year in which they hold their positions.

Finally, file a final disclosure form (Form 1F) within 60 days of leaving office or employment. Filing a CE Form 1F (Final Statement of Financial Interests) does <u>not</u> relieve the filer of filing a CE Form 1 if the filer was in his or her position on December 31, 2019.

NOTICE OF ASSESSMENT OF AUTOMATIC FINE

The Commission on Ethics hereby gives notice of an assessment of a fine against you pursuant to Section 112.3145(8)(g), Florida Statutes, due to your failure to timely file your 2019 CE Form 1, Statement Of Financial Interests. Under the law, your 2019 CE Form 1, Statement of Financial Interests, was due by July 1, 2020. The law provided for a penalty-free grace period extending the due date to September 1, 2020. After that date, you accrued fines of \$25.00 per day for each day your financial disclosure was late, pursuant to Section 112.3145(8)(g), Florida Statutes.

Inasmuch as your 2019 CE Form 1 was filed September 22, 2020 with the Supervisor of Elections for Miami-Dade County, you are fined the amount of \$525.00 (\$25.00 per day for 21 day(s) late). This fine must be paid to the Commission on Ethics within 30 days of the date of this notice unless you appeal the fine to the Commission. The Commission has the authority to consider the appeal and waive the fine in whole or in part if your failure to file on time was due to "unusual circumstances" surrounding the failure to file.

HOW TO APPEAL

- 1. Read these instructions carefully before submitting your appeal.
- 2. **LEGAL AUTHORITY:** Appeals are governed by Section 112.3145(8)(g)3., Florida Statutes, and Commission Rule 34-8.215, Florida Administrative Code.
- 3. **FORMAT:** Your appeal must be in writing and mailed to <u>Florida Commission on Ethics</u>, P. O. <u>Drawer 15709</u>, Tallahassee, FL 32317-5709, or delivered to <u>Florida Commission on Ethics</u>, 325 John Knox Road, <u>Building E, Suite 200</u>, <u>Tallahassee</u>, FL 32303. The appeal may take the form of a letter or you may use the appeal form included in this mailing. The appeal form also is available at the Commission's website: <u>www.ethics.state.fl.us</u>. Click on "Financial Disclosure" and then the link to the sample appeal form.
- 4. **DUE DATE:** Your appeal must be <u>received</u> by the Commission on Ethics on or before <u>March 29, 2021</u>. <u>NOTE</u>: Failure to timely file an appeal will constitute a waiver of your right to appeal and will result in the entry of a default order against you.
- 5. UNUSUAL CIRCUMSTANCES: An appeal must demonstrate that you submitted your CE Form 1 after the extended due date because of "unusual circumstances." "Unusual circumstances" is defined in Commission Rule 34-8.215(4), Florida Administrative Code, as "uncommon, rare, or sudden events over which the reporting individual had no control and which directly result in the failure to act in accordance with the filing requirements." Therefore, circumstances that allowed for time to take steps necessary to file on time do not constitute "unusual circumstances" that will allow the Commission to waive the fine. You have the burden to establish "unusual circumstances." Your appeal must specifically state the circumstances that led to your not filing by September 1, 2020, and must include any documentation or evidence supporting your appeal, such as:
 - a. **SICKNESS/INJURY:** a statement from attending physician, including dates and nature of the illness or injury;
 - b. **LACK OF NOTICE (WRONG ADDRESS):** documentation that you did not reside at the address to which notice was sent;
 - c. LACK OF NOTICE (ABSENCE FROM HOME): documentation establishing the period of time of your absence covering the notification period;

- d. **CLAIM OF TIMELY FILING OF FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE:** (1) an affidavit from you attesting under oath or affirmation that you filed your financial disclosure and your recollection of when and how you filed and (2) a copy of a certified mail receipt and/or a copy of the completed form which was filed. If you have witnesses to your filing, we also will need an affidavit from each witness. If you do not request a hearing, you will waive your right to a hearing, the Commission will determine the outcome of your appeal based upon the written record (including the documentation you provide and any documentation in your case file), and you will receive no further notice until after the Commission decides your appeal.

FAILURE TO PAY FINE OR FILE APPEAL WITHIN 30 DAYS

If you do not timely file an appeal or pay the assessed fine within 30 days of this Notice, a default order will be entered against you and the Commission will take the steps provided by law to collect the fine, including:

- Referral to the CFO of the Department of Financial Services, if you are a salaried state officer or employee, for withholding of a portion of you salary until the fine is satisfied; or
- Referral to your agency's governing body for withholding of a portion of your salary until the fine is satisfied;
- Referral to a collection agency, which can seek garnishment of your wages; and/or
- An additional civil penalty, not limited by this automatic fine, may be imposed if your disclosure statement is filed more than 60 days late and a complaint is filed against you pursuant to Section 112.324, Florida Statutes.


