FINAL ORDER

This matter came before the Commission on Ethics, meeting in public session on January 21, 2022, on the timely appeal of Appellant, pursuant to Section 112.3145(8)(g), Florida Statutes, which assesses an automatic fine of \$25 per day on a person who fails to timely file a required CE Form 1, Statement of Financial Interests. The Commission may waive the fine in whole or in part for good cause shown, based on "unusual circumstances" surrounding the failure to file by the designated date. There are no matters in dispute. Appellant has not requested a hearing before the Commission.

Findings of Fact

- 1. According to information provided to the Commission, Appellant served as a member of the Police Officers' Trust Fund Board for the City of Melbourne, a position requiring the filing of a CE Form 1, Statement of Financial Interests, for the year 2019. In 2020, the designated due date for submitting a 2019 CE Form 1 annual filing was July 1, 2020, with a grace period ending on September 1, 2020.
- 2. No later than June 1, 2020, the Brevard County Supervisor of Elections sent Appellant notice of the July 1, 2020, filing deadline and a blank 2019 CE Form 1 for him to complete.

- 3. No later than July 31, 2020, the Brevard County Supervisor of Elections sent Appellant a notice by certified mail concerning his filing obligation.
- 4. On August 20, 2020, the Commission on Ethics mailed Appellant a postcard intended to remind him of his obligation to file a 2019 CE Form 1. The Commission mailed the postcard to Appellant at 3682 North Wickham Road, Suite C, Melbourne, Florida.
- 5. On September 9, 2020, the Commission on Ethics sent Appellant a courtesy notice indicating that fines were beginning to accrue as his 2019 CE Form 1 had not been received.
- 6. Because Appellant did not file his 2019 CE Form 1 within 60 days of the expiration of the grace period—September 1, 2020—he accrued the maximum fine amount of \$1,500.
- 7. The Commission sent Appellant a Notice of Assessment of his Automatic Fine on March 16, 2021. The Notice was sent to the 3682 North Wickham Road address. It indicated the total of Appellant's accrued automatic fine, and included a notice of the right to appeal the fine, stating that the appeal had to be received by the Commission by April 15, 2021.
- 8. Appellant submitted his appeal on April 13, 2021. In the appeal, Appellant emphasized he has been a public pension trustee for 25 years and, due to ongoing pain and health-related reasons, he has not attended a City Police Pension Board meeting since approximately July 2020. He indicated his resignation from the Board became official on February 11, 2021. Appellant claimed in particular that, in June 2020, he contracted the COVID-19 virus. He also claimed additional health-related issues had occurred, such as a broken bone in his foot and a neuroma in his right leg that needed to be amputated.
- 9. On April 22, 2021, nine days after submitting his appeal, Appellant contacted the Commission on Ethics and told a Commission representative that he has had COVID-19 and broken his foot, and that he "has been in and out of [the] hospital."

10. Appellant subsequently submitted his 2019 CE Form 1 on June 14, 2021.¹

Conclusions of Law

- 11. The Commission has jurisdiction over the subject matter of this proceeding pursuant to Section 112.3145, Florida Statutes.
- 12. Financial disclosure is required of public officials and employees because it enables the public to evaluate potential conflicts of interest, deters corruption, and increases public confidence in government.
 - 13. Section 112.3145(8)(g), Florida Statutes, states:

Any reporting person may appeal or dispute a fine, based upon unusual circumstances surrounding the failure to file on the designated due date, and may request and is entitled to a hearing before the commission, which may waive the fine in whole or in part for good cause shown. Any such request must be in writing and received by the commission within 30 days after the notice of payment due is transmitted. In such a case, the reporting person must, within the 30-day period, notify the person designated to review the timeliness of reports in writing of his or her intention to bring the matter before the commission. For purposes of this subparagraph, the term "unusual circumstances" does not include the failure to monitor an e-mail account or failure to receive notice if the person has not notified the commission of a change in his or her e-mail address.

14. Here, Appellant indicates that, in June 2020, immediately before the July 1, 2020, deadline for submitting the 2019 CE Form 1, he contracted COVID-19. Appellant also indicates that he broke a bone in his foot and developed a neuroma in his right leg that needed to be amputated. Considering these health-related reasons, as well as that Commission records show Appellant has filed for each Form year since 2006 and has incurred no other fines for untimely filing, there are "unusual circumstances" here that justify waiving the \$1,500 fine.

¹ Commission records reflect that on that same date, June 14, 2021, Appellant also submitted his 2020 CE Form 1 and 2021 CE Form 1F.

<u>Order</u>

Based on the foregoing facts and conclusions of law, the Commission hereby waives the assessed fine of \$1,500.

I received your letter about my tardiness at getting back the statement of financial interest for 2019, and potential fines.

For the record, I have been a trustee for four municipal pension plans over about 25 years and donated hundreds and hundreds of hours of my time, when I could have been working for a living those same hours. It's hard for me to think that because I screwed up something and didn't get a form in the appropriate time, that at the state might charge me \$1500. I can't imagine this happening.

On top of all the health issues I have gone through, last week I was informed I am out a job.

And right now, of COVID-19, partly because I broke a bone in my foot, and partly because of a neuroma in my right leg that had to be amputated, I'm not in a position to pay a fine.

I've been doing volunteer work for no pay for eight or nine years for the City of Melbourne and before that I volunteered for three pension boards in Satellite Beach, going back over 25 years.

I believed that I had submitted the 2019 form in June 2020, but it I may have sent the 2018 for both years, for 2018 and for 2019.

The last Board meeting I that I attended was probably July of last year.

In about Sep of last year, I let Jennifer Chase from the City of Melbourne Police Pension Board didn't think I could keep spending the time for the duties of being the Secretary or even on the Board of the City pension Plan.

She reminded me about my financial statement several times, but I informed her that I was terminating as a trustee for personal reasons.

Apparently, the City shows me being a trustee up to 2/11/2021 even though my last meeting was probably July of 2020. I have not been involved with the city pension plan since July 2020.

I would like to get a waiver from you're the fine discussed your letter to me dtd 3/16/2021.

I can provide your "Final Statement of Financial Interest" form for 2019, and 2020, require medical records from all the doctors and hospitals I've been at in the last two years. That would cost me more time than paying the \$1500 fine. Put it, that would make you happy. I will do my best to put that together.

Jennifer Chase from the Melbourne police pension plan knows that the reason that I missed the last three meetings was either because of doctors, hospitals or just pain issues.

If I could fax you all of my medical billing statements you could see what I have been trough.

If you really want it, I guess I can get hold of all these doctors and hospitals and have them give me reports.

Otherwise, I'd be happy to send you copies of all of my shares of all the doctors and hospital bills have had in the last year or so. I got the virus in June of last year and got through that, but then my two assistants walked out on me because of the virus, and I can't run my business without help and I have been trying to do it on my own since then, and it's just about impossible.

However as of April 30 I am out of business.

I am not the position to pay a fine.



NOTICE OF ASSESSMENT OF AUTOMATIC FINE

The Commission on Ethics hereby gives notice of an assessment of a fine against you pursuant to Section 112.3145(8)(g), Florida Statutes, due to your failure to timely file your 2019 CE Form 1, Statement Of Financial Interests. Under the law, your 2019 CE Form 1, Statement of Financial Interests, was due by July 1, 2020. The law provided for a penalty-free grace period extending the due date to September 1, 2020. After that date, you accrued fines of \$25.00 per day for each day your financial disclosure was late, up to the maximum fine of \$1,500.00 (60 days late), pursuant to Section 112.3145(8)(g), Florida Statutes.

Inasmuch as your 2019 CE Form 1 has not been filed with the Supervisor of Elections for Brevard County within the 60 days of the grace period date (September 1, 2020), you have accrued the maximum fine amount of \$1,500.00. This fine must be paid to the Commission on Ethics within 30 days of the date of this notice unless you appeal the fine to the Commission. The Commission has the authority to consider the appeal and waive the fine in whole or in part if your failure to file on time was due to "unusual circumstances" surrounding the failure to file. Unless the fine is successfully appealed, the Commission is required to investigate public officers and employees who receive the maximum \$1,500 fine, to determine whether their failure to file was willful. The penalty for willfully failing to file disclosure is removal from public office or employment.

HOW TO APPEAL

- 1. Read these instructions carefully before submitting your appeal.
- 2. **LEGAL AUTHORITY:** Appeals are governed by Section 112.3145(8)(g)3., Florida Statutes, and Commission Rule 34-8.215, Florida Administrative Code.
- 3. **FORMAT:** Your appeal must be in writing and mailed to Florida Commission on Ethics, P. O. Drawer 15709, Tallahassee, FL 32317-5709, or delivered to Florida Commission on Ethics, 325 John Knox Road, Building E, Suite 200, Tallahassee, FL 32303. The appeal may take the form of a letter or you may use the appeal form included in this mailing. The appeal form also is available at the Commission's website: www.ethics.state.fl.us. Click on "Financial Disclosure" and then the link to the sample appeal form.
- 4. **DUE DATE:** Your appeal must be <u>received</u> by the Commission on Ethics on or before <u>April 15, 2021.</u> NOTE: Failure to timely file an appeal will constitute a waiver of your right to appeal and will result in the entry of a default order against you.
- 5. UNUSUAL CIRCUMSTANCES: An appeal must demonstrate that you submitted your CE Form 1 after the extended due date because of "unusual circumstances." "Unusual circumstances" is defined in Commission Rule 34-8.215(4), Florida Administrative Code, as "uncommon, rare, or sudden events over which the reporting individual had no control and which directly result in the failure to act in accordance with the filing requirements." Therefore, circumstances that allowed for time to take steps necessary to file on time do not constitute "unusual circumstances" that will allow the Commission to waive the fine. You have the burden to establish "unusual circumstances." Your appeal must specifically state the circumstances that led to your not filing by September 1, 2020, and must include any documentation or evidence supporting your appeal, such as:
 - a. SICKNESS/INJURY: a statement from attending physician, including dates and nature of the illness or injury;

- b. LACK OF NOTICE (WRONG ADDRESS): documentation that you did not reside at the address to which notice was sent;
- LACK OF NOTICE (ABSENCE FROM HOME): documentation establishing the period of time of your absence covering the notification period;
- d. CLAIM OF TIMELY FILING OF FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE: (1) an affidavit from you attesting under oath or affirmation that you filed your financial disclosure and your recollection of when and how you filed and (2) a copy of a certified mail receipt and/or a copy of the completed form which was filed. If you have witnesses to your filing, we also will need an affidavit from each witness. NOTE: A claim of having filed the CE Form 1F for the current year does not satisfy the CE Form 1 filing requirement or excuse a late filing;
- e. **LEFT PUBLIC POSITION BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 2019:** confirmation of your last date of office or employment by your former agency, showing the last date to be before December 31, 2019; or
- f. UNCLAIMED CERTIFIED MAIL: if deliquency notice was addressed correctly but not received, you must explain why.
- 6. YOUR RIGHT TO A HEARING: You have the right to have your appeal heard by the Commission and to appear before the Commission at the hearing, but, to exercise this right, you must specifically request a hearing in your appeal. If you do not request a hearing, you will waive your right to a hearing, the Commission will determine the outcome of your appeal based upon the written record (including the documentation you provide and any documentation in your case file), and you will receive no further notice until after the Commission decides your appeal.

FAILURE TO PAY FINE OR FILE APPEAL WITHIN 30 DAYS

If you do not timely file an appeal or pay the assessed fine within 30 days of this Notice, a default order will be entered against you and the Commission will take the steps provided by law to collect the fine, including:

- Referral to the CFO of the Department of Financial Services, if you are a salaried state officer or employee, for withholding of a portion of you salary until the fine is satisfied; or
- Referral to your agency's governing body for withholding of a portion of your salary until the fine is satisfied:
- · Referral to a collection agency, which can seek garnishment of your wages; and/or
- An additional civil penalty, not limited by this automatic fine, may be imposed if your disclosure statement is filed more than 60 days late and a complaint is filed against you pursuant to Section 112.324, Florida Statutes.




