FINAL ORDER

This matter came before the Commission on Ethics, on its own motion, meeting in public session on March 10, 2023, in the matter of Adam Weisholtz (Appellant), pursuant to Section 112.3145(8)(g) [formerly, Section 112.3145(7)(f)], Florida Statutes, which assesses an automatic fine of \$25 per day on a person who fails to timely file a required CE Form 1, Statement of Financial Interests. The Commission may waive the fine in whole or in part for good cause shown, based on "unusual circumstances" surrounding the failure to file by the designated date. There are no matters in dispute. Appellant requested a hearing before the Commission.

Findings of Fact

- 1. According to information provided to the Commission, Appellant is a member of the Judicial Nominating Commission for the 15th Judicial Circuit, a position requiring the filing of a CE Form 1, Statement of Financial Interests, for the year 2020. The designated due date for submitting a 2020 CE Form 1 annual filing was July 1, 2021, with a grace period ending on September 1, 2021.
- 2. On May 26, 2021, the Commission on Ethics sent Appellant a 2020 CE Form 1. This mailing was sent to: 170 NE 2nd Street, #732, Boca Raton, FL 33429. It is unknown if Appellant received this mailing.

- 3. On July 30, 2021, the Commission on Ethics sent Appellant a Notice of Delinquency by certified mail. This notice was also sent to the 170 NE 2nd Street address. It is unknown if Appellant received this mailing.
- 4. On August 19, 2021, the Commission mailed Appellant a postcard intended to remind him of his obligation to file a 2020 CE Form 1. The Commission mailed the postcard to the 170 NE 2nd Street address. It is unknown if Appellant received this mailing.
- 5. On September 8, 2021, seven days after the grace period expired, the Commission mailed Appellant a courtesy notice informing him that his 2020 CE Form 1 had not been received, and that an automatic fine had begun to accrue. The Commission mailed this notice to the 170 NE 2nd Street address. It is unknown if Appellant received this mailing.
- 6. On September 24, 2021, the United States Postal Service returned the Notice of Delinquency, originally sent on July 30, 2021, to the Commission because it was not deliverable as addressed.
- 7. On August 5, 2022, Appellant submitted his 2020 CE Form 1 to the Commission on Ethics.
- 8. The total amount of the fine automatically assessed against Appellant was the maximum of \$1,500 for submitting his CE Form 1 late by more than 60 days.
- 9. On September 19, 2022, the Commission received Appellant's appeal of the automatic fine. In the appeal, Appellant stated that he did not receive any of the correspondence sent by the Commission.
- 10. In his appeal, Appellant claims that on October 20, 2020, he changed his address to 604 Banyan Trail, #810261, Boca Raton, FL 33481 as shown by a USPS P.O. Box Customer Agreement, and updated his address on the Florida Bar website on the same day. Appellant

explained in his appeal that the address used to mail the CE Form 1 and other related notices—170 NE 2nd Street, #732, Boca Raton, FL 33429—was an old address. Appellant stated in his appeal that his correct address was 604 Banyan Trail, #810261, Boca Raton, FL 33481.

Conclusions of Law

- 11. The Commission has jurisdiction over the subject matter of this proceeding pursuant to Section 112.3145, Florida Statutes.
- 12. Financial disclosure is required of public officials and employees because it enables the public to evaluate potential conflicts of interest, deters corruption, and increases public confidence in government. In order to increase compliance, beginning in 2001 the Legislature provided for an automatic fine of \$25 per day, up to a cap of \$1,500, on persons who do not timely file their financial disclosure statements. Under the law, the Legislature permitted the Commission to waive a fine only "based upon unusual circumstances surrounding the failure to file on the designated due date"
 - 13. Commission Rule 34-8.215, F.A.C., defines "unusual circumstances" as follows: uncommon, rare or sudden events over which the reporting individual has no control and which directly result in the failure to act in accordance with the filing requirement. Circumstances which allow for time in which to take those steps necessary to assure compliance with the filing requirement shall be deemed not to constitute unusual circumstances.
- Appellant's basis for the appeal of his fine is that he was unable to timely file his 2020 CE Form 1 because he did not receive any of the notices sent in the mail that would have alerted him to the obligation to file. The mailings were sent to an address that Appellant was no longer using, an address at which he was no longer receiving mail. Given these facts and Appellant's assertion that he did not receive the mailings, there is no evidence that Appellant personally received notice of his filing obligation before the expiration of the grace period.

Taking into account that there is no evidence that Appellant received the notices concerning his filing obligation, we find this to constitute "unusual circumstances" that justify waiving the \$1,500 fine.

<u>Order</u>

Based on the foregoing facts and conclusions of law, the Commission hereby waives the assessed fine of \$1,500.

Part C: Detailed explanation

I filed my 2020 CE Form 1 after the filing deadline due to unusual circumstances. In this case, those unusual circumstances were lack of notice.

I did not receive any of the correspondence mailed to me by the Commission on Ethics during the year 2021, including the 5/26/2021 regular notice and the 7/30/2021 certified notice advising of the Sept 30th deadline. I would have filed my Form 1 in a timely manner, if I would have received those notices, as evidenced by my timely filings in all other years I served on the Judicial Nominating Commission.

As evidence of my lack of notice, I am attaching the following documentation:

- (1) USPS Mail Piece Detail tracking sheet (printed 8/24/2022), showing that the certified notification letter was mailed 7/29/2021, but remained in transit with USPS for nearly two months, until it was finally returned to the "Original Sender" on 9/24/2021.
- (2) USPS proof of delivery, showing the certified notification letter was not delivered to me, but, rather, was returned to the "Original Sender" on 9/24/2021, and signed for by a USPS employee in Tallahassee.
- (3) USPS P.O. Box Customer Agreement and payment receipt showing my address was changed to 604 Banyan Trail, #810261, Boca Raton, FL 33481, on 10/20/2020, which predates all notices mailed to me by the Commission on Ethics. Please note that my professional address was updated with the Florida Bar simultaneously on the date I signed the agreement for the new post office box and was accessible to the public.

MULTIPLE FILING UNNECESSARY: A candidate who files a Form 1 with a qualifying officer is not required to file with the Commission or Supervisor of Elections.


WHEN TO FILE: *Initially*, each local officer/employee, state officer, and specified state employee must file *within 30 days* of the date of his or her appointment or of the beginning of employment. Appointees who must be confirmed by the Senate must file prior to confirmation, even if that is less than 30 days from the date of their appointment.

Candidates must file at the same time they file their qualifying papers.

Thereafter, file by July 1 following each calendar year in which they hold their positions.

Finally, file a final disclosure form (Form 1F) within 60 days of leaving office or employment. Filing a CE Form 1F (Final Statement of Financial Interests) does <u>not</u> relieve the filer of filing a CE Form 1 if the filer was in his or her position on December 31, 2020.

NOTICE OF ASSESSMENT OF AUTOMATIC FINE

The Commission on Ethics hereby gives notice of an assessment of a fine against you pursuant to Section 112.3145(8)(g), Florida Statutes, due to your failure to timely file your 2020 CE Form 1, Statement Of Financial Interests. Under the law, your 2020 CE Form 1, Statement of Financial Interests, was due by July 1, 2021. The law provided for a penalty-free grace period extending the due date to September 1, 2021. After that date, you accrued fines of \$25.00 per day for each day your financial disclosure was late, pursuant to Section 112.3145(8)(g), Florida Statutes.

Inasmuch as your 2020 CE Form 1 was filed August 5, 2022 with the Commission on Ethics, you are fined the amount of \$1500.00 (\$25.00 per day for 60 day(s) late). This fine must be paid to the Commission on Ethics within 30 days of the date of this notice unless you appeal the fine to the Commission. The Commission has the authority to consider the appeal and waive the fine in whole or in part if your failure to file on time was due to "unusual circumstances" surrounding the failure to file. Unless the fine is successfully appealed, the Commission is required to investigate public officers and employees who receive the maximum \$1,500 fine, to determine whether their failure to file was willful. The penalty for willfully failing to file disclosure is removal from public office or employment.

HOW TO APPEAL

- 1. Read these instructions carefully before submitting your appeal.
- 2. **LEGAL AUTHORITY:** Appeals are governed by Section 112.3145(8)(g)3., Florida Statutes, and Commission Rule 34-8.215, Florida Administrative Code.
- 3. **FORMAT:** Your appeal must be in writing and mailed to <u>Florida Commission on Ethics</u>, P. O. <u>Drawer 15709</u>, <u>Tallahassee</u>, <u>FL 32317-5709</u>, or delivered to <u>Florida Commission on Ethics</u>, <u>325 John Knox Road</u>, <u>Building E, Suite 200</u>, <u>Tallahassee</u>, <u>FL 32303</u>. The appeal may take the form of a letter or you may use the appeal form included in this mailing. The appeal form also is available at the Commission's website: <u>www.ethics.state.fl.us</u>. Click on "Financial Disclosure" and then the link to the sample appeal form.
- 4. **DUE DATE:** Your appeal must be <u>received</u> by the Commission on Ethics on or before <u>October 7, 2022</u>. <u>NOTE</u>: Failure to timely file an appeal will constitute a waiver of your right to appeal and will result in the entry of a default order against you.
- 5. UNUSUAL CIRCUMSTANCES: An appeal must demonstrate that you submitted your CE Form 1 after the extended due date because of "unusual circumstances." "Unusual circumstances" is defined in Commission Rule 34-8.215(4), Florida Administrative Code, as "uncommon, rare, or sudden events over which the reporting individual had no control and which directly result in the failure to act in accordance with the filing requirements." Therefore, circumstances that allowed for time to take steps necessary to file on time do not constitute "unusual circumstances" that will allow the Commission to waive the fine. You have the burden to establish "unusual circumstances." Your appeal must specifically state the circumstances that led to your not filing by September 1, 2021, and must include any documentation or evidence supporting your appeal, such as:
 - a. **SICKNESS/INJURY:** a statement from attending physician, including dates and nature of the illness or injury;
 - b. **LACK OF NOTICE (WRONG ADDRESS):** documentation that you did not reside at the address to which notice was sent;

- c. LACK OF NOTICE (ABSENCE FROM HOME): documentation establishing the period of time of your absence covering the notification period;
- d. **CLAIM OF TIMELY FILING OF FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE:** (1) an affidavit from you attesting under oath or affirmation that you filed your financial disclosure and your recollection of when and how you filed and (2) a copy of a certified mail receipt and/or a copy of the completed form which was filed. If you have witnesses to your filing, we also will need an affidavit from each witness. NOTE: A claim of having filed the CE Form 1F for the current year does not satisfy the CE Form 1 filing requirement or excuse a late filing;
- LEFT PUBLIC POSITION BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 2020: confirmation of your last date of
 office or employment by your former agency, showing the last date to be before December 31, 2020;
 or
- f. **UNCLAIMED CERTIFIED MAIL**: if deliquency notice was addressed correctly but not received, you must explain why.
- 6. **YOUR RIGHT TO A HEARING:** You have the right to have your appeal heard by the Commission and to appear before the Commission at the hearing, but, to exercise this right, you must specifically request a hearing in your appeal. If you do not request a hearing, you will waive your right to a hearing, the Commission will determine the outcome of your appeal based upon the written record (including the documentation you provide and any documentation in your case file), and you will receive no further notice until after the Commission decides your appeal.

FAILURE TO PAY FINE OR FILE APPEAL WITHIN 30 DAYS

If you do not timely file an appeal or pay the assessed fine within 30 days of this Notice, a default order will be entered against you and the Commission will take the steps provided by law to collect the fine, including:

- Referral to the CFO of the Department of Financial Services, if you are a salaried state officer or employee, for withholding of a portion of you salary until the fine is satisfied; or
- Referral to your agency's governing body for withholding of a portion of your salary until the fine is satisfied:
- Referral to a collection agency, which can seek garnishment of your wages; and/or
- An additional civil penalty, not limited by this automatic fine, may be imposed if your disclosure statement is filed more than 60 days late and a complaint is filed against you pursuant to Section 112.324, Florida Statutes.




