# FINAL ORDER RESCINDING FINE

This matter came before the Commission on Ethics, meeting in public session on March 8, 2024, on the timely appeal of Appellant, pursuant to Section 112.3145(8)(g) [formerly Section 112.3145(7)(f)], Florida Statutes, which assesses an automatic fine of \$25 per day on a person who fails to timely file a required CE Form 1, Statement of Financial Interests. The Commission may waive the fine in whole or in part for good cause shown, based on "unusual circumstances" surrounding the failure to file by the designated date. There are no matters in dispute. Appellant did request a hearing before the Commission.

# Findings of Fact

- 1. According to information provided to the Commission, Appellant served as a member of the Board of Supervisors of the Dog Island Conservation District, a position requiring the filing of a CE Form 1, Statement of Financial Interests, for the year 2018. In 2019, the designated due date for submitting a 2018 CE Form 1 annual filing was July 1, 2019, with a grace period ending on September 3, 2019.
- 2. No later than June 1, 2019, the Hillsborough County Supervisor of Elections sent Appellant a 2018 CE Form 1. This mailing was sent to Appellant at Dog Island Conservation District, 3612 W. San Pedro Street, Tampa, FL 33629. The mailing was returned as undeliverable.

- 3. No later than July 31, 2019, the Hillsborough County Supervisor of Elections sent Appellant a Notice of Delinquency by certified mail. This Notice was sent to the 3612 W. San Pedro Street address. The notice was returned as undeliverable.
- 4. On August 19, 2019, the Commission mailed Appellant a postcard intended to remind him of his obligation to file a 2018 CE Form 1. The Commission mailed the postcard to the 3612 W. San Pedro Street address. It is unknown if Appellant received this mailing.
- 5. On September 6, 2019, three days after the grace period expired, the Commission mailed Appellant a courtesy notice informing him that his 2018 CE Form 1 had not been received by the Hillsborough County Supervisor of Elections and that he was being fined \$25 per day, up to a maximum of \$1,500. The Commission mailed this notice to the 3612 W. San Pedro Street address. It is unknown if Appellant received this mailing.
- 6. On February 4, 2020, the Commission sent Appellant a Notice of Assessment of Automatic Fine by certified mail to the 3612 W. San Pedro Street address, which indicated that Appellant had accrued a \$1,500 fine and informed him of his right to appeal the fine. It stated that the appeal had to be received by the Commission by March 5, 2020, to be considered timely. Records from the United States Postal Service indicate that, on March 4, 2020, the certified mailing was returned due to a problem with the address.
- 7. On June 11, 2021, following the expiration of the appeal period, the Commission sent Appellant a Final Notice of Assessment of Automatic Fine for failure to timely file his 2018 CE Form 1. This notice was sent to the 3612 W. San Pedro Street address. It is unknown if Appellant received this mailing.
- 8. On September 15, 2021, the Commission mailed Appellant a Notification of Issuance of Default Final Order, which confirmed his \$1,500 fine and instructed him to pay the

fine by October 15, 2021. This was sent to the 3612 W. San Pedro Street address. It is unknown if Appellant received this mailing.

- 9. On November 12, 2021, the staff of the Commission had a phone conversation with Appellant. The Commission updated his email address and updated his mailing address to 2406 W. Country Club Avenue, Tampa, FL 33611. The Commission emailed Appellant a Notice of Assessment of Automatic Fine, an appeal form and a 2018 CE Form 1. The Notice indicated that Appellant had accrued a \$1,500 fine and informed him of his right to appeal the fine. It stated that the appeal had to be received by the Commission by December 13, 2021, to be considered timely. The Notice of Assessment was emailed rather than mailed at Appellant's request.
- 10. On December 13, 2021, the Commission received Appellant's 2018 CE Form 1 and his completed Appeal of Automatic Fine for Form Year 2018, which had been signed on December 12, 2021.
- 11. In his appeal, Appellant claimed he did not receive timely notice of his obligation to file the 2018 CE Form 1. Appellant states in his appeal that all notices were sent to his previous address. He stated that he had rented the property out for two years before selling it in May 2017 but that he had not lived there since 2015.

# Conclusions of Law

- 12. The Commission has jurisdiction over the subject matter of this proceeding pursuant to Section 112.3145, Florida Statutes.
- 13. Financial disclosure is required of public officials and employees because it enables the public to evaluate potential conflicts of interest, deters corruption, and increases public confidence in government.

14. Section 112.3145(8)(f)2., Florida Statutes, states:

Any reporting person may appeal or dispute a fine, based upon unusual circumstances surrounding the failure to file on the designated due date, and may request and is entitled to a hearing before the commission, which may waive the fine in whole or in part for good cause shown. Any such request must be in writing and received by the commission within 30 days after the notice of payment due is transmitted. In such a case, the reporting person must, within the 30-day period, notify the person designated to review the timeliness of reports in writing of his or her intention to bring the matter before the commission. For purposes of this subparagraph, the term "unusual circumstances" does not include the failure to monitor an e-mail account or failure to receive notice if the person has not notified the commission of a change in his or her e-mail address.

- 15. Appellant's appeal is accepted as timely. The record contains no evidence that Appellant received notice containing his appellate rights until November 12, 2021, and Appellant filed his appeal by the deadline stated in the Notice of Assessment (December 13, 2021).
- 16. With regard to the substance of the appeal, Appellant claims he did not receive timely notice of his filing obligation and there is no evidence to dispute this. In support of this, the certified mailing sent by the Hillsborough County Supervisor of Elections was returned due to its having an undeliverable address. Due to the information provided to the Commission, including postal records, Appellant's statements and documentation provided with his appeal, we find Appellant's reason for appealing to constitute "unusual circumstances" that justify rescinding the \$1,500 fine.

### Order

Based on the foregoing facts and conclusions of law, the Commission hereby rescinds the Default Final Order entered on September 15, 2021, and waives the assessed fine of \$1,500.

# NOTICE OF ASSESSMENT OF AUTOMATIC FINE

The Commission on Ethics hereby gives notice of an assessment of a fine against you pursuant to Section 112.3145(8)(g), Florida Statutes, due to your failure to timely file your 2018 CE Form 1, Statement Of Financial Interests. Under the law, your 2018 CE Form 1, Statement of Financial Interests, was due by July 1, 2019. The law provided for a penalty-free grace period extending the due date to September 3, 2019. After that date, you accrued fines of \$25.00 per day for each day your financial disclosure was late, up to the maximum fine of \$1,500.00 (60 days late), pursuant to Section 112.3145(8)(g), Florida Statutes.

Inasmuch as your 2018 CE Form 1 has not been filed with the Supervisor of Elections for Hillsborough County within the 60 days of the grace period date (September 3, 2019), you have accrued the maximum fine amount of \$1,500.00. This fine must be paid to the Commission on Ethics within 30 days of the date of this notice unless you appeal the fine to the Commission. The Commission has the authority to consider the appeal and waive the fine in whole or in part if your failure to file on time was due to "unusual circumstances" surrounding the failure to file. Unless the fine is successfully appealed, the Commission is required to investigate public officers and employees who receive the maximum \$1,500 fine, to determine whether their failure to file was willful. The penalty for willfully failing to file disclosure is removal from public office or employment.

### **HOW TO APPEAL**

- 1. Read these instructions carefully before submitting your appeal.
- 2. **LEGAL AUTHORITY:** Appeals are governed by Section 112.3145(8)(g)3., Florida Statutes, and Commission Rule 34-8.215, Florida Administrative Code.
- 3. FORMAT: Your appeal must be in writing and mailed to Florida Commission on Ethics, P. O. # **DEFAULT FINAL ORDER**

This matter comes before the Commission on Ethics for the failure of Mr Leroy Collins III to pay the assessed fine. Pursuant to Section 112.3145(8)(g), Florida Statutes, the Florida Commission on Ethics is charged with assessing automatic fines of \$25 per day up to a maximum of \$1500 for persons who are required to file financial disclosure but who either file late, or not at all.

# FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Mr Leroy Collins III, Dog Island Conservation District, Board of Supervisors, was on the list of persons required to file a Statement of Financial Interests for the year 2018.
- 2. Pursuant to Section 112.3145(8)(g), Florida Statutes, Mr Leroy Collins III was mailed a copy of the 2018 CE Form 1 no later than June 1, 2019, and was mailed a delinquency notice by certified mail no later than July 31, 2019. Additional attempts to contact Mr Leroy Collins III were also made by Commission staff.
- 3. However, Mr Leroy Collins III did not file a 2018 CE Form 1 by the designated due date. Mr Leroy Collins III was sent a notice of payment due advising of the statutory rights to appeal or dispute the automatic fine in a hearing before the Commission if such appeal was received within 30 days of the notice of payment due. No timely appeal was received from Mr Leroy Collins III.

- 4. More than 60 days have elapsed since the notice of payment due was transmitted without Mr Leroy Collins III paying the fine.
- 5. On its own motion, the Commission voted to affirm that a fine in the amount of \$1500 has accrued in this matter.

# **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 6. The Commission has jurisdiction over the parties to and subject matter of this case, pursuant to Section 112.3145, Florida Statutes.
- 7. Mr Leroy Collins III's failure to timely appeal the assessed fine constitutes a waiver of the entitlement to an appeal, pursuant to Rule 34-8.215(2), Florida Administrative Code.

### **ORDER**

- 8. Pursuant to Section 112.3145(8) and 112.31455, Florida Statutes, the Commission on Ethics shall attempt to determine whether Mr Leroy Collins III is currently a public officer or public employee receiving salary or wages from a governmental entity. If so, the matter will be referred to either the Chief Financial Officer for the State of Florida or the governing body for Dog Island Conservation District, as appropriate, for withholding of salary until the debt is satisfied.
- 9. If Mr Leroy Collins III is no longer a public officer or employee, or if the Commission cannot determine filer's status, the matter will be referred to the Florida Department of Financial Services for collection or wage garnishment.

WHEREFORE, the automatic fine that Mr Leroy Collins III accrued in the amount of \$1500 is affirmed. The fine shall be paid to the Florida Commission on Ethics within 30 days of

the date this Default Final Order is entered. After that date, nonpayment will result in collection as provided for in Section 112.3145(8) and 112.31455, Florida Statutes.




