#### FINAL ORDER

This matter came before the Commission on Ethics, meeting in public session on January 24, 2025, on the appeal of Appellant, pursuant to Section 112.3145(8)(f), Florida Statutes, which assesses an automatic fine of \$25 per day on a person who fails to timely file a required CE Form 1, Statement of Financial Interests. The Commission may waive the fine in whole or in part for good cause shown, based on "unusual circumstances" surrounding the failure to file by the designated date. There are no matters in dispute. Appellant did not request a hearing.

# Findings of Fact

- 1. According to information provided to the Commission, Appellant served as a member of the South Palm Beach Planning Board, a position requiring the filing of a 2020 CE Form 1, Statement of Financial Interests. In 2021, the designated due date for submitting a 2020 CE Form 1 was July 1, 2021, with a grace period ending on September 1, 2021.
- 2. By June 1, 2021, the Supervisor of Elections of Palm Beach County sent Appellant a 2020 CE Form 1. This letter was sent to Appellant at 4201 S. Ocean Blvd., Apt. 1M, South Palm Beach, FL 33480.
- 3. By August 1, 2021, the Supervisor of Elections of Palm Beach County sent Appellant a notice of delinquency by certified mail. This notice was sent to Appellant at the 4201

- S. Ocean Blvd., Apt. 1M, address. This notice was returned undelivered and marked "Return to Sender Unclaimed."
- 4. On August 20, 2021, the Commission on Ethics mailed Appellant a postcard intended to remind him of his obligation to file a 2020 CE Form 1. The Commission mailed the postcard to the 4201 S. Ocean Blvd., Apt. 1M address.
- 5. On September 8, 2021, the Commission on Ethics mailed Appellant a courtesy notice of fines accruing. This was sent to the 4201 S. Ocean Blvd., Apt. 1M address.
  - 6. To date, Appellant still has not submitted a completed 2020 CE Form 1.
- 7. On October 9, 2023, the Commission mailed Appellant a notice of assessment of his automatic fine. The notice was sent by mail to the 4201 S. Ocean Blvd., Apt. 1M address. It indicated the total of Appellant's accrued automatic fine was \$1,500.00 (\$25 per day for 60 days late) and provided that the Commission must receive an appeal of the fine by November 8, 2023.
- 8. On November 7, 2023, the Commission received Appellant's appeal of his automatic fine for Form Year 2020. Appellant wrote his appeal in the form a letter. In this letter, Appellant stated he never served as a Board member of the South Palm Beach Planning Board, because, though he agreed to serve on the Board, the Board never met in 2020 and he took no official action as a Board member. Appellant further contended that, even if he was a Board member, he was excused from the 2020 CE Form 1 filing requirement because he resigned from the Board on June 7, 2021.

# Conclusions of Law

9. The Commission has jurisdiction over the subject matter of this proceeding pursuant to Section 112.3145, Florida Statutes.

10. Financial disclosure is required of public officials and employees because it enables the public to evaluate potential conflicts of interest, deters corruption, and increases public confidence in government.

# 11. Section 112.3145(8)(f)2., Florida Statutes, states:

Any reporting person may appeal or dispute a fine, based upon unusual circumstances surrounding the failure to file on the designated due date, and may request and is entitled to a hearing before the commission, which may waive the fine in whole or in part for good cause shown. Any such request must be in writing and received by the commission within 30 days after the notice of payment due is transmitted. In such a case, the reporting person must, within the 30-day period, notify the person designated to review the timeliness of reports in writing of his or her intention to bring the matter before the commission. For purposes of this subparagraph, the term "unusual circumstances" does not include the failure to monitor an e-mail account or failure to receive notice if the person has not notified the commission of a change in his or her e-mail address.

Here, Appellant stated: (1) he was not a Board member because the Board never met in 2020 and he took no action as a Board member; and (2) he was relieved from the requirement of filing of a 2020 CE Form 1 by virtue of his resignation from the Board on June 7, 2021. The lack of meetings during Appellant's tenure as a Board member, and his resignation on June 7, 2021, do not constitute an "unusual circumstance" that would prevent someone from timely filing his or her CE Form 1 for 2020. Per the evidence submitted by Appellant, he was appointed to the Planning Board on April 28, 2020, and resigned on June 7, 2021. By virtue of both his appointment and his resignation, Appellant served as a Board member, regardless of whether the Board met during Appellant's tenure. Appellant's appointment to the Board through the end of the year subjected him to the 2020 CE Form 1 filing requirement. His resignation on June 1, 2021, did not relieve him of the requirement of filing a 2020 CE Form 1 he had already incurred. Thus,

considering Appellant's claims, it does not appear that there was an "unusual circumstance" that prevented him from timely filing his 2020 CE Form 1 by September 1, 2021.

#### Order

Based on the foregoing facts and conclusions of law, the Commission hereby finds that unusual circumstances for the failure to file timely have not been demonstrated. We therefore affirm the assessed fine of \$1,500.00. The fine shall be paid to the Commission on Ethics, P.O. Drawer 15709, Tallahassee, FL 32317-5709, within 30 days of the date this order is rendered, unless other payment arrangements are made by contacting Kimberly Holmes, Financial Disclosure Program Administrator, at the address above or by telephone at (850) 488-7864.

To Whom It May Concern:

Please accept this writing as a formal appeal, pursuant to Section 112.3145(8)(g)3., Florida Statutes and Commission Rule 34-8.215 of the Florida Administrative Code, of the abovementioned Notice of Assessment of Automatic Fine (the "Notice") due to an alleged failure to file 2020 CE Form 1, Statement of Financial Interests (the "Statement").

As an initial matter, the Notice alleges that I served as a board member of the South Palm Beach Planning Board (the "Board") during calendar year 2020. However, that allegation is inaccurate. Although I informally agreed to serve on the Board in some capacity, no formalities were undertaken. I was never sworn in or otherwise admitted to the Board. I took no official act as an alleged board member. I never sat for a meeting, attended a hearing, or lodged even one single vote. Said differently, I never acted as a member of the Board. Attached hereto is an e-mail from Glen J. Torcivia, Esq., counsel to the Board, confirming that the Board has not even held a meeting since 2016.

Even if the Commission in inclined to believe I was a member of the Board (thus triggering the requirement to submit the Statement), I was affirmatively advised that no such Statement was necessary. When I first learned that a Statement was required of me, I tendered a "resignation", rather than potentially serve on the Board. At that time, I was advised by Yude Davenport, Town Clerk/Assistant to the Town Manager/Records Custodian, Town of South Palm Beach, that

my "resignation" obviated any need to prepare the Statement.

Of course, Ms. Davenport's position on the Statement evolved after she advised me that my resignation was sufficient. Delivered with the Notice is a certain e-mail thread where Ms. Davenport was instructed that, despite my resignation, the Statement was still due. The e-mail attached to the Notice goes on to show that on or about August 19, 2021, Ms. Davenport e-mailed me to advise that her previous statement to me was incorrect, that a Statement was still required. Notably, I am the only party on that e-mail that was not marked "Read" thereon.

When Ms. Davenport contacted me via e-mail, I had already been under the impression that the Statement was not necessary, so I had no reason to engage her with future correspondence. Had I seen Ms. Davenport's about-face e-mail, I would have prepared the Statement within the time period required.

For all of the foregoing reasons, I respectfully request that Automatic Fine pursuant to Section 112.3145(8)(g), Florida States be waived or, at the very least, mitigated under the circumstances.

As I advised you there is a former member of the Town's Planning Board, John Conroy, who has been assessed a fine in the amount of \$1,500.00 for failing to file Form 1 for the year 2020. During our conversation you advised me that there is another member of the South Palm Beach, Planning Board, Kelly Caldwell, who has had multiple years where she has been fined for not filing Form 1.

As I mentioned to you, I do not represent either Mr. Conroy or Ms. Caldwell. As we discussed, Mr. Conroy was appointed to the Planning Board on April 28, 2020, and he resigned on June 7, 2021. During that period of time, the Planning Board never met.

As to Ms. Caldwell, I'm not certain as to the date she was appointed to the Board however, the same is true that the Board has not met since January 16, 2016. Please let me know if there is any possibility of either individual having their fines waived or reduced in light of the above information.

#### NOTICE OF ASSESSMENT OF AUTOMATIC FINE

The Commission on Ethics hereby gives notice of an assessment of a fine against you pursuant to Section 112.3145(8)(g), Florida Statutes, due to your failure to timely file your 2020 CE Form 1, Statement Of Financial Interests. Under the law, your 2020 CE Form 1, Statement of Financial Interests, was due by July 1, 2021. The law provided for a penalty-free grace period extending the due date to September 1, 2021. After that date, you accrued fines of \$25.00 per day for each day your financial disclosure was late, up to the maximum fine of \$1,500.00 (60 days late), pursuant to Section 112.3145(8)(g), Florida Statutes.

Inasmuch as your 2020 CE Form 1 has not been filed with the Supervisor of Elections for Palm Beach County within the 60 days of the grace period date (September 1, 2021), you have accrued the maximum fine amount of \$1,500.00. This fine must be paid to the Commission on Ethics within 30 days of the date of this notice unless you appeal the fine to the Commission. The Commission has the authority to consider the appeal and waive the fine in whole or in part if your failure to file on time was due to "unusual circumstances" surrounding the failure to file. Unless the fine is successfully appealed, the Commission is required to investigate public officers and employees who receive the maximum \$1,500 fine, to determine whether their failure to file was willful. The penalty for willfully failing to file disclosure is removal from public office or employment.

#### **HOW TO APPEAL**

- 1. Read these instructions carefully before submitting your appeal.
- 2. **LEGAL AUTHORITY:** Appeals are governed by Section 112.3145(8)(g)3., Florida Statutes, and Commission Rule 34-8.215, Florida Administrative Code.
- 3. **FORMAT:** Your appeal must be in writing and mailed to <u>Florida Commission on Ethics</u>, P. O. <u>Drawer 15709</u>, <u>Tallahassee</u>, <u>FL 32317-5709</u>, or delivered to <u>Florida Commission on Ethics</u>, <u>325 John Knox Road</u>, <u>Building E, Suite 200</u>, <u>Tallahassee</u>, <u>FL 32303</u>. The appeal may take the form of a letter or you may use the appeal form included in this mailing. The appeal form also is available at the Commission's website: <u>www.ethics.state.fl.us</u>. Click on "Financial Disclosure" and then the link to the sample appeal form.
- 4. **DUE DATE:** Your appeal must be <u>received</u> by the Commission on Ethics on or before <u>November 8, 2023.</u> <u>NOTE</u>: Failure to timely file an appeal will constitute a waiver of your right to appeal and will result in the entry of a default order against you.
- 5. UNUSUAL CIRCUMSTANCES: An appeal must demonstrate that you submitted your CE Form 1 after the extended due date because of "unusual circumstances." "Unusual circumstances" is defined in Commission Rule 34-8.215(4), Florida Administrative Code, as "uncommon, rare, or sudden events over which the reporting individual had no control and which directly result in the failure to act in accordance with the filing requirements." Therefore, circumstances that allowed for time to take steps necessary to file on time do not constitute "unusual circumstances" that will allow the Commission to waive the fine. You have the burden to establish "unusual circumstances." Your appeal must specifically state the circumstances that led to your not filing by September 1, 2021, and must include any documentation or evidence supporting your appeal, such as:
  - a. SICKNESS/INJURY: a statement from attending physician, including dates and nature of the illness or injury;
  - b. LACK OF NOTICE (WRONG ADDRESS): documentation that you did not reside at the address to which notice was sent;

- c. LACK OF NOTICE (ABSENCE FROM HOME): documentation establishing the period of time of your absence covering the notification period;
- d. CLAIM OF TIMELY FILING OF FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE: (1) an affidavit from you attesting under oath or affirmation that you filed your financial disclosure and your recollection of when and how you filed and (2) a copy of a certified mail receipt and/or a copy of the completed form which was filed. If you have witnesses to your filing, we also will need an affidavit from each witness. NOTE: A claim of having filed the CE Form 1F for the current year does not satisfy the CE Form 1 filing requirement or excuse a late filing;
- e. LEFT PUBLIC POSITION BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 2020: confirmation of your last date of office or employment by your former agency, showing the last date to be before December 31, 2020; or
- f. UNCLAIMED CERTIFIED MAIL: if deliquency notice was addressed correctly but not received, you must explain why.
- 6. YOUR RIGHT TO A HEARING: You have the right to have your appeal heard by the Commission and to appear before the Commission at the hearing, but, to exercise this right, you must specifically request a hearing in your appeal. If you do not request a hearing, you will waive your right to a hearing, the Commission will determine the outcome of your appeal based upon the written record (including the documentation you provide and any documentation in your case file), and you will receive no further notice until after the Commission decides your appeal.

#### FAILURE TO PAY FINE OR FILE APPEAL WITHIN 30 DAYS

If you do not timely file an appeal or pay the assessed fine within 30 days of this Notice, a default order will be entered against you and the Commission will take the steps provided by law to collect the fine, including:

- Referral to the CFO of the Department of Financial Services, if you are a salaried state officer or employee, for withholding of a portion of you salary until the fine is satisfied; or
- Referral to your agency's governing body for withholding of a portion of your salary until the fine is satisfied:
- Referral to a collection agency, which can seek garnishment of your wages; and/or
- An additional civil penalty, not limited by this automatic fine, may be imposed if your disclosure statement is filed more than 60 days late and a complaint is filed against you pursuant to Section 112.324, Florida Statutes.




