TALLAHASSEE—September 2, 2026 — The State of Florida Commission on Ethics, during its public session meeting on August 28, elected **JEREMY M. RODGERS** as Chair for the 2026-2027 term, beginning September 3, 2026. Mr. Rodgers was appointed to the Commission by Governor Ron DeSantis in June 2025 and reappointed in August 2026. Rodgers is a technology and cybersecurity leader with extensive experience in government, private industry, and the military. He previously served as Florida's State Chief Information Security Officer, where he led statewide cybersecurity strategy and operations, and spent more than 20 years in the private sector in technology and cybersecurity leadership roles supporting government, defense, and intelligence organizations. He also served six years on the Boca Raton City Council, including as Deputy Mayor. A U.S. Navy Commander, Mr. Rodgers currently serves as

commanding officer of a Navy Reserve Information Operations unit. **JON M.**

PHILIPSON was elected Vice Chair for the 2026-2027 term. Mr. Philipson was appointed to the Commission by Governor DeSantis in 2025. A Tampa-based shareholder with Gunster, he specializes in business litigation, arbitration, and antitrust law. A top graduate and Rhodes Scholar finalist, Mr. Philipson clerked for a federal judge and has a background in public service. He is also active in mentoring the next generation of legal professionals.
